# **Jeremiah 1:10 (NIV)**

**See, today I appoint you  
over nations and kingdoms  
to uproot and tear down, to  
destroy and overthrow, to  
build and to plant.”**



**7. God has a goal for your  
Limitations; they are to be:  
uprooted, torn down,  
destroyed, overthrown, with  
something better built and  
planted in its place**

**Jeremiah 1:12 (NIV)**

**The Lord said to me,**

**“You have seen correctly,  
for I am watching to see  
that my word is fulfilled.”**



**Jeremiah 1:12 (ESV)**

**Then the Lord said to me, “You have seen well, for I am watching over my word to perform it.”**
