Case study with Moses and the Israelites

1 important Lift from the followers that every leader and ministry will need

Exodus 17:10 (KJV) So Joshua did as Moses had said to him, and fought with Amalek: and Moses, Aaron, and Hur went up to the top of the hill.

Exodus 17:11 (KJV) And it came to pass, when Moses held up his hand, that Israel prevailed: and when he let down his hand, Amalek prevailed.

Exodus 17:12 (KJV) But Moses' hands were heavy;

and they took a stone, and put it under him, and he sat thereon;

and Aaron and Hur stayed up his hands, the one on the one side, and the other on the other side; and his hands were steady until the going down of the sun.

Exodus 17:13 (NIV) So Joshua overcame the Amalekite army with the sword.

Exodus 17:14 (NIV) Then the Lord said to Moses, "Write this on a scroll as something to be remembered and make sure that Joshua hears it, because I will completely blot out the name of Amalek from under heaven."
