Words of Comfort

Isaiah 40:1 (NIV) Comfort, comfort my neople, savs voir God

Why? What's the Strategy

Isaiah 40:3 (ESV) A voice cries: "In the wilderness prepare the way of the Lord; make straight in the desert a highway for our God.

Isaiah 40:4 (ESV) Every valley shall be lifted up, and every mountain and hill be made low; the uneven ground shall become level, and the rough places a plain.


Isaiah 40:5 (ESV) And the glory of the Lord shall be revealed, and all flesh shall see it together, for the mouth of the Lord nas spoken."

HOW does this relate to Comfort

1 Thessalonians 4:16 (KJV) For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first:

1 Thessalonians 4:17 (KJV) Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord.

1 Thessalonians 4:18 (KJV) Wherefore comfort one another with these words.



Isaiah 40:28 (KJV) Hast thou not known? hast thou not heard, that the everlasting God, the Lord, the Creator of the ends of the earth, fainteth not, neither is weary? there is no searching of his understanding.

Isaiah 40:29 (KJV) He giveth power to the faint; and to them that have no might he increaseth strength.

Isaiah 40:30 (KJV) Even the youths shall faint and be weary, and the young men shall utterly fall:

Isaiah 40:31 (KJV) But they that wait upon the Lord shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint.
