


Kinglom: 1. a realm under the control of a particular person or thing 2. the spiritual reign or authority of God. the rule of God or Christ in a future age.




Triumph: 1. a great victory or achievement 2. joy or satisfaction resulting from a success or victory
















Mark 111 As they approached Jerusalem and came to Bethphage and Bethany at the Mount of Olives, Jesus sent two of his disciples,

Nark 1 They went and found a colt outside in the street, tied at a doorway. As they untied it,


Mark 115 some people standing there asked, "What are you doing, untying that colt?"

Mark 116 They answered as Jesus had told them to, and the people let them go.




Nark 11-7 When they brought the colt to Jesus and threw their cloaks over it, he sat on it.

Mark 11 10 "Blessed is the coming kingdom of our father David!" "Hosanna in the highest heaven!"


What is so Triumphant about this? Why would they care? Why should we care?













1. We Represent the tied donkey 2. The reason we won't stay bound, is because the King needs us 3. No one can stop us from being untied


Hebrews 11:39 All these people earned a good reputation because of their faith, yet none of them received all that God had promised.

Isaiah 623 You will be a crown of splendor in the LORD's hand, a royal diadem in the hand of your God.










Isaiah 62:6 I have posted watchmen on your walls, Jerusalem; they will never be silent day or night. You who call on the LORD, give vourselves no Rest.








Isaiah 62.7 and give him no rest till he establishes Jerusalem and makes her the praise of the earth.
